98% of participants would recommend the Nurse Scholar program to others.




91% of participants said that after taking the program, they intended on making a change to their practice and/or personal life.



98% of participants said the program met the overall learning outcomes.


Participants were asked to rate their knowledge about agricultural health exposures BEFORE taking the Nurse Scholar Program on a scale from 1 (Nothing) to 5 (A lot). They were then asked the same question, but in regards to their knowledge AFTER taking the program.



BEFORE taking the program 6% of participants rated their knowledge as "A lot" and 10% rated their knowledge as as a 4.



AFTER taking the program 63% of participants rated their knowledge as "A lot", and 33% rated their knowledge as a 4.
